Each financial aid opportunity will require that you apply for the scholarship by a certain deadline. This application deadline will vary. In this document you will find the deadlines for the University of Haifa Financial Aid and the University of Haifa Presidential Merit Scholarships. ## Financial Aid Opportunities

The following is a list of scholarships that we know of at this time. Eligibility for the scholarships varies and usually includes factors such as merit, financial need, length of program, religion, and nationality. You will need to review the details of each scholarship individually to determine whether you are eligible.

**University of Haifa Financial Aid:** Available to students studying in any program of the International School who demonstrate financial need.

**Presidential Merit Scholarship:** Available to students studying for at least one semester in the International School who demonstrate academic excellence.
